Collection: Collection Planning & Security

Introduction

- Information collected without a specific reason is a waste of valuable time and resources. In a world where the flow of new information is fast and constant, an organisation cannot afford to lag behind. It is essential that information collection is highly organised to ensure the latest intelligence reaches decision makers before its value is overtaken by events.
- Consideration must also be given to the security of information search and collection. Indiscreet research can render future intelligence production worthless.
- This course will teach collection managers how to select the best source to answer specific tasking based on cost, ability to respond and the speed of response required. The course will also teach participants how to manage the information requirements of customers against source capabilities using collection management worksheets.

Course content

- The collection plan.
- Multiple tasking to confirm the validity of information.
- Identification of relevant and timely sources.
- Tasking sources of information.
- Security of intention and purpose.



Target audience

- This course is aimed at information and intelligence office managers. It will also be beneficial for researchers to attend the course so that they become aware of the constraints under which information managers operate.
